Other older members of our congregation may have shared my sense of being 'on the edge' during the lockdown. But we have the resource of prayer and we may have the resource of money. Indeed, for some of us, our money is one of the most powerful tools that we have for the work of God's kingdom.

Christian Aid, like all charities, has suffered a loss of income because of the pandemic, which has only increased the need for its work. We were not able to use May's Christian Aid Week for our normal appeal to the public beyond the church, but the appeal to our own community has traditionally been made through our contributions each October to the **URC's Commitment for Life programme**. We cannot use the usual C for L envelopes this October, but


would you consider making your gift in another way some time during the autumn?

Graham Manson, our Treasurer, has agreed to handle the appeal and would appreciate gifts made in one of two ways:

- a. by a **cheque sent to the church** (The Treasurer, Christ Church, Old Market Avenue, Chichester PO19 1SW) made out to the church, but with the cheque and/or envelope **clearly marked 'Commitment for Life'**,
- b. by **Bank Transfer** direct into the church's account (Sort Code 40-52-40 Account 00033603)

If you are a tax payer please increase your donation by 25% through Gift Aid, adding a note about that to the back of the cheque or to the description given on the online bank transfer. It is likely that your details for that will already be held by the church but, if not, please be ready to give them to Graham if he asks.

None of us is as marginalised as those truly 'on the edge' in places of destruction or poverty across the world. But our gifts to Christian Aid will help to bring some of those people nearer to the centre of the good life that God wants for all of us.
